

Fairmont u14/u15 Pro20 Cricket Challenge 2012



TOURNAMENT DETAILS

1. Team to consist of an equi-split of u14 and u15 players (6x u14 players and 6x u15 players)
2. We hope not to deviate from 6x players from each age-group, however show flexibility due to circumstance
3. Team to consist of only 12 players & 2 officials
4. Team to play in their official school / club / academy colors throughout the Tournament
5. Umpires and scorers will be provided for all matches
6. 156g cricket balls will be used and provided for all matches
7. There is 1 section with 6 teams
8. Each team will play 5 round-robin matches against all the other teams in their section
9. Finals for the 1st/2nd, 3rd/4th and 5th/6th positions will be played
10. The final session (weather permitting) will be fun/skills session
11. **Teams play a minimum of 6 matches**
12. A Pro20 match is a limited 20 overs per team
13. The 1st 6 overs are powerplay overs, a maximum of 4 overs per bowler is allowed, min 4 overs of spin applies, the free hit rule will apply
14. The winner of a fixture shall be the team with the highest score
15. The finishing order of a section shall be determined by points position determined by the no. of wins, and where scores are tied by net run rate
16. Matches are played at the Fairmont HS A and B fields and Durbanville CC fields (all within 5km radius from Fairmont High School)
17. Team entry **includes** player registration for all matches, players and officials ID cards, liquid refreshments provided at all matches, all lunches as provided at the Fairmont main field (Student Centre), Opening Function, Closing Function/Prize-giving/Guest-speaker/Auction
